Carbon Reduction Plan

2026 Targets (Completed)

- Calculate emissions & create sustainability policy
- Review suppliers for florals and switch to a more local wholesaler
- Conduct Sustainability training with team to increase awareness
- Complete a NCFE Level 2 Business Improvement course aimed at eliminating waste & Lean manufacturing practices
- Add sustainability information to our online presence to increase awareness to our clients
- Improve operating procedures internally to minimise waste through travel, costs, working hours, down time, admin & use of equipment
- Switched where possible to foam free-floral arrangements

2026 Targets - Ongoing

- Continue to promote our sustainable business by associating with other sustainable businesses - including Wedding Venues
- Minimise Travel emissions by narrowing down our geographic area of catchment for wedding styling
- Continue with the use of artificial & sustainable locally grown florals where possible to reduce the impact of importing fresh flowers
- Recycle all packaging waste from deliveries and re-use bubble wrap
- Increase use of reussable props to reduce single-use purchases by developing our DIY prop hire service
- Dry our own wedding confetti rather than purchasing & importing dried flowers

2027+ Targets

- Switch to a paper based bubble wrap for our glass items to reduce single use plastic
- Introduce a hire-first approach to reduce new purchases of props and encourage re-use
- Transition to 100% foam free floristry across all weddings
- Build a preferred supplier network focused on low-impact and ethical practices
- Track and monitor all transport emissions to identify further reductions

Before 2030 Targets

- Research into switching our delivery vans to electric powered vehicles - or other low-emissions vehicles
- Reduce overall emissions by at least 30%
- Source majority of florals from UK based suppliers
- Operate using only the inventory we own - always repurposing and repairing rather than replacing
- Minimise waste sent to landfill through recycling & composting green waste
- Work towards carbon-conscious wedding package for clients
- Explore carbon offsetting options for unavoidable emissions.
